Street Scholarships will start on the evening after the Freestyle Scholarships

Candidates for the IDTA Street Scholarships are initially nominated by the Association's Examiners when taking a Street Solo medal test at Star 1 level or above, through a qualified teacher.

Candidates must obtain a mark of at least 90% and show outstanding / exceptional potential.

Awards are granted in the following age groups for Street Solo performances:

Class A – Under 16

Class B – 16 year and over

The Scholarships will be held annually in the Spring. Nominations are taken from 1 March to 28/29 February the following year.

Winners will receive a trophy and a cheque prize to further their dance training.

Certificates are awarded to every nominee.

An additional trophy and voucher towards further training to be presented by Anna Jones for the nominees in each age group showing outstanding potential

Format of Scholarships

All nominees will participate in a class (Class A, Class B, depending on age) after a warm up.

Approximately 12 semi finalists from each age group will be selected to give a solo performance, followed by a repeat solo performance by approximately 6 finalists.

Solo performances will be in age groups and will be 30 seconds in length, choreographed by teacher. (Dances must be Street Based rather than Freestyle)

Judges will select the winner from each age group.

Class taught by guest choreographer
Class A up to 15 years inc.

Class B 16 years and over

1. Dress:

Clothing should be plain throughout the day Suitable Street clothing with footwear No school logos No sequins/gems etc No ornate head gear

2. Music:

For the class, music will be provided by the class instructor – radio edit.

For the solo performance:

Music for Class A and B will be provided by the Freestyle Faculty.

Separate track information for Class A and Class B will be provided in advance of the competition.

3. Age Groups:

Class A – up to 15 years inc.

Class B - 16 years and over inc.

The nominee's age on the date of the finals will determine the class / age group they participate in. It is essential that the nominee's date of birth is provided by their teacher when acknowledging the nomination to Head Office.

4. Registration:

All nominees are required to register 45 minutes prior to the commencement of their class. Failure to do so may result in them being unable to take part.

- **5.** Re-dances will not be allowed except in the case of music failure or at the discretion of the MC.
- **6.** In the event of a nominated candidate being unable to take part, entry <u>may not</u> be deferred to the following year.
- 7. In the event of a nominated candidate changing schools, written permission to take part must be supplied by both school principals.
- **8.** In accordance with Child Protection Guidance video cameras, cameras and mobile phone cameras may not be used. A professional photographer will be in attendance. Any objections to the photographing of the scholarships should be submitted in writing to IDTA one month before the event.

9. Entry fees:

For nominees and spectators £12 in advance and £15 on the door if available.

10. Exclusions:

Rotating no-handed movements are not allowed. Chest rolls are not allowed.

11. Professional qualifications:

Nominees who are training for any professional exams in any genre cannot participate in the Scholarships.

Please note that candidates who violate <u>any</u> of the rules will be disqualified.
